The theme for this year was highlighted "Our time is now –

our rights, our future". The invited guests were Mrs. Rachana from Van stop, Mrs. Sultan Khan, Ms. Jaishree the women police and Village Sarpanch and the elders were present for the celebration.

The Speakers highlighted the importance of the rights of the girl children, and it's their time now to be unitedly raise their voice to get justice. Mrs. Rachana enlightened in her speech that girls need to be aware of the environment and the surroundings



where they live. Each girl need to be courageous enough to talk to parents openly. To avail the Government schemes and facilities to enhance the potentialities of the girl children.

The Children performed a skit which highlighted the struggles of the woman. The



enactment of the skits moved the participants and the guests in tears. They were few speakers who shared their knowledge in encouraging the girl children to achieve their motto of "Our time is now –our rights, our future". There were few slogans which children raised by themselves. Many more children came forward to speak about the children in today's society. The children

A concern was raised in regard to Right to Education, that children are able to study up to 10^{th} and they are unable to pursue their higher education due to poverty or the parent's unwillingness.

At the end of the programme the children were given a lighted candles and take oath that we they would study well and will not enter into any unwanted evil things.
