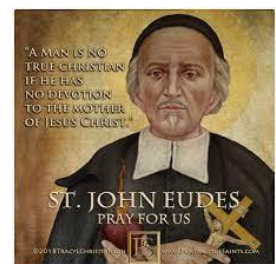




Feast of St. John Eudes Marked with Joyful Perpetual Profession
